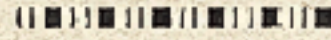

## ORGANIZATION.

---

This Order is composed of a National Council, a Board of Directors, and such State and Subordinate Councils as are now, and as may be hereafter established.

The National Council is the highest authority in the Order, and is composed of the Incorporators, present National Officers (without vote in National elections), and officers and representatives of State Councils. Such Council meets annually in March for legislative purposes, and biennially in such month for the election of Officers and a Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors is the executive body of the Order, and meets quarterly, for the transaction of business.

On January 1st, 1899, there were 400 Councils in the Order, having a membership of 22,005 in the Insured Class, and 20,262 in the Associate Class.
